## Snapshot of Ohio Pregnancy-Associated Deaths, 2008-2019\*


From 2008 through 2016, there were 610 pregnancy-associated deaths in Ohio 70% (n=428) occurred in the postpartum period, up to 1 year after pregnancy 31% (n=131) of those occurred within 6 weeks of pregnancy

**31%** (n=186) were determined to be pregnancy-related.

• The most common cause of death was cardiovascular and coronary conditions **16%**  **60%** (n=368)


